Bristol Avon Rivers Trust have been working quietly in the Congresbury Yeo catchment over the last couple of years developing our knowledge of the river and just what needs doing to improve it for the benefit of wildlife and people. We have completed our surveys of the area from the lakes to the estuary and made many friends along the way. We have also engaged local people in our Waterblitz looking at water quality in the river. 2021 will be an even busier year and BART want to hear from you if you want to be involved.

Activities we plan next year - subject to covid disruptions – include

Setting up an invertebrate monitoring network

River Dipping

Eel in the Classroom sessions for some local schools.

A Congresbury Yeo Waterblitz involving communities and as many local people as possible.

Our own water quality investigations across the catchment.

Community talks to share what we have found.

Restoration and local flooding improvement projects with local partners.

Tree planting
