## A Gesture of Kindness in the Midst of Chaos

Chaos struck on Monday 25th November when Romany Poppitt-Price set out to attend her brother-in-law's funeral in Swindon. Road closures and heavy traffic made it impossible for Romany and her partner, Mick, to get out of Banwell and reach the motorway. After trying every route they could, they eventually had no choice but to turn back home, disappointed, but accepting that the circumstances were beyond their control.

As Romany sat with the sadness of not being able to say goodbye in person, her thoughts turned to how she might honour John's memory in a meaningful way. She remembered the food bank's Christmas appeal for chocolate treats for families in need, and decided that an act of generosity would be a fitting tribute.

#### A Small Action That Makes a Real Difference

Through easyfundraising, over 8,000 retailers, including well-known names such as John Lewis, Boots, Marks & Spencer, and Argos, will make a small donation to the church every time you shop with them online.

Importantly, it doesn't cost you anything extra. The donation comes from the retailer, not the shopper.

This means that the ordinary, everyday purchases you're already making can quietly and consistently help fund the ongoing life and mission of our church.

## Why We're Encouraging It

Many of us want to support the church's work, but finances are stretched for households and individuals. Easyfundraising offers a way to contribute that doesn't place an additional burden on anyone.

It's a gentle form of stewardship; using what we already do, in the course of normal life, to bless the wider church family.

#### How to Join In

It's straightforward:

- 1. Visit easyfundraising.org.uk
- 2. Search for one of our church charities (St Andrew's Church Congresbury or New Creation) and select it as your cause
- 3. Create a free account
- 4. Shop online as usual

If you like, you can install their optional "donation reminder" tool, which simply lets

you know when a retailer participates.

As with many things in church life, the beauty of easyfundraising is in the collective effort. One person's donation might be tiny, but when many of us take part, those small gifts grow into meaningful support for our ministry, outreach, and buildings.
