My thought for the week Happy and peaceful New Year to all. 2026 heralds in the next milestone for us as a church community in Congresbury. We are to enter a new season of change. The proposal that had been submitted to the District Committee to decommission and sell our Chapel might become a reality. All future worship after that will be held in the refurbished Hall. Our Chapel celebrated 150 years of worship last September. Although I have worshiped in the Chapel only for the last 4 years, the nostalgia I feel is nonetheless poignant. However, the chapel building is only of bricks and mortar. Jesus Christ is the true cornerstone (Ephesians 2:20-22) of wherever God leads us to worship.

It would not be unreasonable though, for many of us to have reservations and disquiet thoughts on the wisdom of this change of venue for worship, albeit a seemingly sensible and advantageous move. There are numerous issues to address, not least the logistics of the project and whether if our perseverance will last the duration of transition. The ultimate vision of this change is to enable us to broaden our Christian Discipleship. Hopefully, this change of venue will enhance and extend the atmosphere of us being the warm and welcoming Christians that we already are. Our outreach can be even more impactful.

However, this vision and hope will not be fulfilled without God leading the way. If this project is God led, He will make smooth our path, as in Proverbs 3:16 - 'Remember the Lord in everything you do, and He will show you the right way'. Jesus Christ, Immanuel (God with us) came down to earth so that we can understand the inspired scripture in Hebrews 13:5, 'Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you.' This knowledge that God will always be with us gives us assurance especially in this time of uncertainty. Going forward, let us prayerfully ask God to lead and inspire the Property Stewards and Project Committee. We pray earnestly that God will grant them clarity and the discernment of His will. 'Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct your paths' Proverbs 3:5-6.
