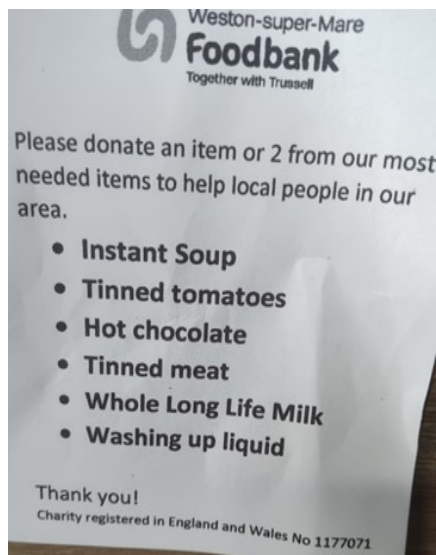

Church Council Meeting. The most
important item on the agenda was the fact
that we had an overview by an electrician
with regards the electrics in the Hall and
he said they were so bad and dangerous
we needed to shut the doors immediately
(which we have done). The cost of
renewing the wiring etc. is well out of our
reach and not viable therefore the doors
will be closed indefinitely. All people using
the Hall have been notified and can use the
church. Any queries please speak to Mary
who will keep you of any changes if there
are any.

Also on the agenda was whether we revoke
the decision to keep the Hall and sell the
Church. It was unanimously agreed that we
should especially because of the state it is
in and that to upgrade was going to be far
out of our reach as well as having
permission to do so. This means we shall
be keeping our church and already we have
some quotes to improve the roof and
hopefully have some other work done in the
not too distant future. There has been a
growing feeling from our members for quite
a while that we keep the church. Also talk-
ing to villagers outside there have been
strong feelings that we keep the church.
As always it is as God wills so we pray that
He leads us forward into the future and
that we continue to show His love to those
we meet whether it is during our worship or
Bible study/prayer meetings or our monthly
Outreach mornings
